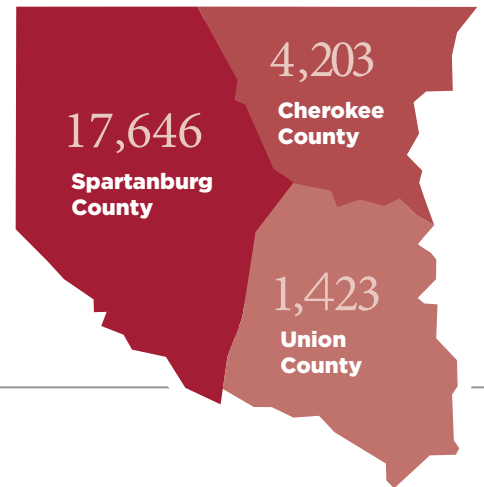


10+ YEARS OF ACCESS TO CARE

THE NEED

More than 23,000 low income residents of Spartanburg, Cherokee and Union counties have no insurance of any kind. **AccessHealth Spartanburg** connects this population to primary and specialty care as well as a host of social services and other assistance. Increasing access to comprehensive, quality healthcare services is important for promoting and maintaining health, preventing and managing disease, reducing unnecessary disability and premature death, and achieving health equity for everyone in our community.



OUR APPROACH

A groundbreaking initiative focused on Spartanburg County when it started in 2010, **AccessHealth Spartanburg** has since expanded into Cherokee and Union counties. Its model for complex case management and the elevation of community health workers have been recognized by national healthcare organizations that include the Center for Health Care Strategies, the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, the Healthcare Leadership Council and the American Public Health Association.
